NOTE: I donate all yarns to ICEHO, so ALL your donation goes to the fund.


















9-11 are knitted (by Verena Lechner, my friend from Vorarlberg who supports ICEHO)

NEXT PAGE: All socks are made from sock yarn (75% new wool, 25% synthetic) unless otherwise stated. A "D" means that heels and toe are knitted with double yarn for extra sturdiness. Size conversion table at the end of the document.

Yarn cost ca €3 for children's sizes, €6 for adult, unless otherwise stated. Childrens's socks: 4 working hours, female sizes ca. 10 working hours, men's sizes 12 working hours. All numbers per pair!






Size 40, **D**, Aloe-Vera-treated-ecofriendly wool, wool cost € 9;95




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Scrunchies made from shiny yarns, knitted over a rubber hair band. 2,5 h each Material cost €1 each. Available per piece.



Knitted bracelets, wool + cotton (b) yarn cost small. 3 hours each




Convertible cowl/beanie, Alpaka + wool mix, very soft , female size or smaller men's



Convertible cowl/beanie, wool, K12 kid's size yarn cost € 3



The last of the pussyhats. Summer version for small female head. I don't remember wool cost, probably knit in 3 hours.



Linen + cotton crescent shaped shawl with matching headband (large size) (fit for summer/autumn) minimum 12 hours

The following projects are of a different nature. They are bigger works, absolutely unique, because the design is by me – or I used an existing pattern but with different yarns, so you can be sure that this item only exists ONCE.



This is a wave-scarf, made from double strands of lace-weight yarn, so the colors blend, it is very light, almost fluffy and very warm. Stretches. Probably 25 hours or more.






Made from Schoppel Wolle "Zauberperlen", Yarn cost 33 Euros, Merino Handwash. My own color design based on "Crasys Halbmondschal" (freee internet pattern). Uncounted hours, probably close to 50.





Made from "Woll Butt Alva" in colorway "beere", probably 75 hours worth, material is **50** % **Wool, 50**

% **Polyacryl**, so can be washed in lukewarm water. Design by me. Very soft drape. Yarn cost €14,95

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The "sustainability triangle" is always depicted resting on its base, with the tip sticking upwards. I wanted to knit a triangle shawl from sustainable yarn, where the pattern consists of triangles that stand on the top (so they are female triangles). To do this, I knitted triangles into the stockinette background with a center section in stockinette, knitted in garter stitch.

I did a crochet picot edge at the end to keep the shawl from curling too much and to give it some sturdyness. It is undoubtedly more suitable for a smaller woman; very cooling and smooth on the skin, and the colors are cheerful. Difficult to do justice in a photo.

Yarn: Rosários 4 Bio Bamboo Print

Cost of yarn: € 30,-- Hours? Difficult to say, I guess, 35 for the knitting and another 6 for the crochet edge
